What does the State Report Card tell us about the school?



Schools report information for the Ohio Report Cards on specific marks of performance, called measures, within broad categories called components. Cornerstone Academy was evaluated on Achievement, Progress, Improving At-Risk K-3 Readers, and Gap Closing. Descriptions...

Achievement: The Achievement Component represents whether student performance on state tests met established thresholds and how well students performed on tests overall. A new indicator measures chronic absenteeism.

Progress: The Progress Component looks closely at the growth that all students are making based on their past performances.

Improving At-Risk K-3 Readers: The K-3 Readers Component looks at how successful the school is at improving at-risk K-3 readers.

Gap Closing: The Gap Closing Component shows how well schools are meeting the performance expectations for our most vulnerable students in English language arts, math, graduation, and English language proficiency.

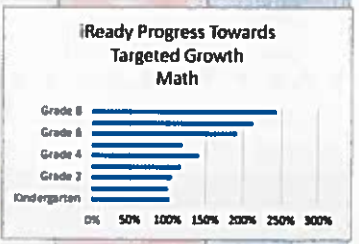

St. Aloysius, as the sponsor of this school, is legally mandated to provide oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance. As part of the monitoring process, the performance of the school on each of the required Ohio School Report Card components is assessed and evaluated. Additionally, St. Aloysius has a regular presence at school board meetings where student performance indicators such as attendance, behavior, and academic achievement are tracked and financial and organizational issues that impact student success are reviewed and discussed. Keys to oversight, monitoring, and support is St. Aloysius's review of the school's Ohio Improvement Process (OIP) plan development and implementation. As a result of our thorough oversight and monitoring, St. Aloysius has determined that this school is substantially compliant with the rules and regulations governing community schools.
