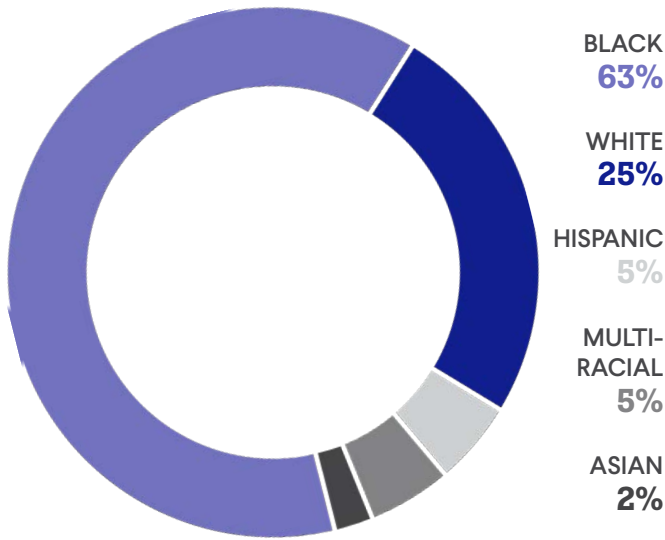

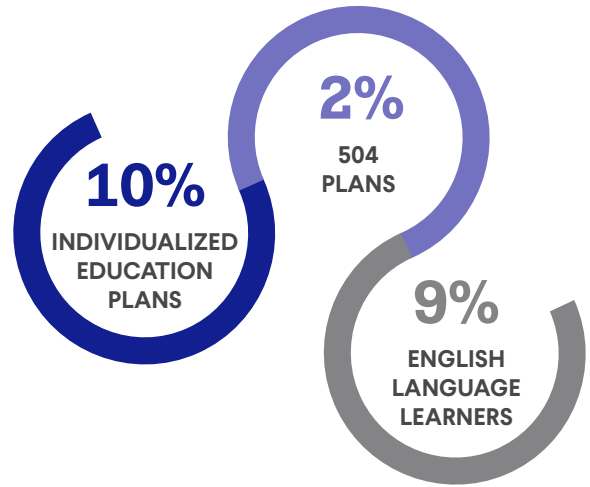

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



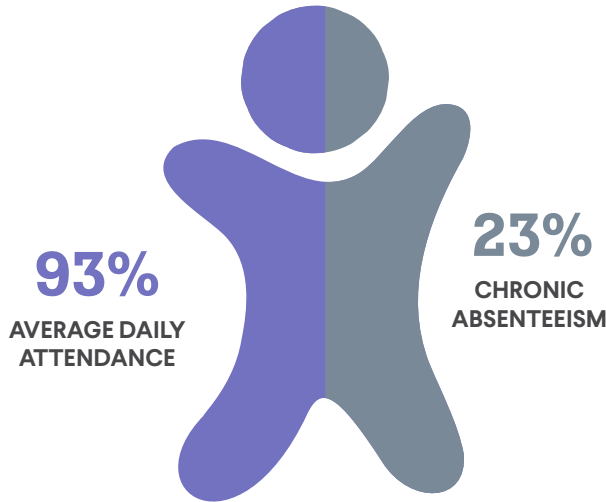

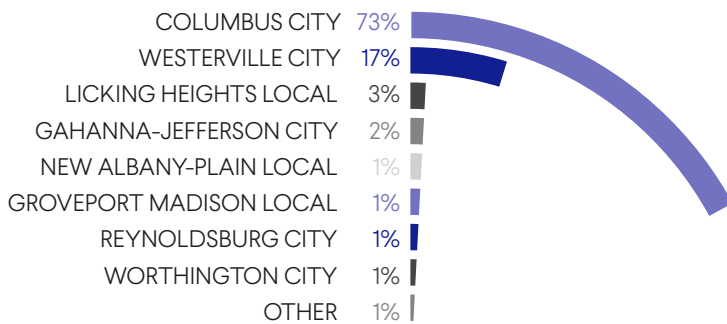

HIGHLIGHTS

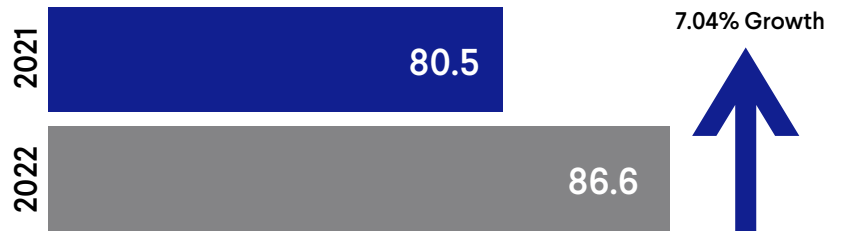
ACADEMIC PROGRESS

The academic goals of Cornerstone Academy during the 2021-22 school year were to raise performance on the Ohio State Test (and diagnostic assessments) by 10% for English Language Arts and for Math; Also to initiate and cultivate the VWE and RAGES writing initiatives to raise student eligibility and participation for College Credit Plus by 10%.

Cornerstone Academy met the expectations of the Ohio Department of Education in all components including exceeding expectations in student academic growth (4 Stars, Progress) and significantly exceeding expectations in closing educational gaps (5 Stars, Gap Closing).

Additionally, the strong focus on Writing increased student eligibility and participation in College Credit Plus by over 200%-- a program where students can earn college as well as high school credit for a number of classes in partnership with Columbus State University.

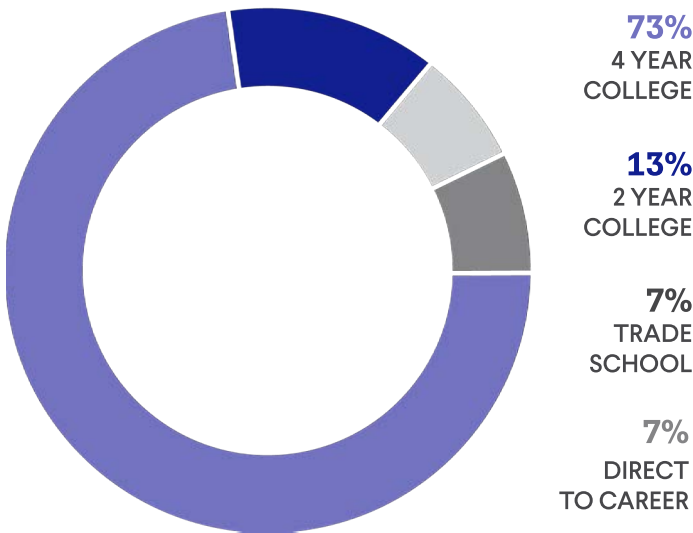
CLASS OF 2022



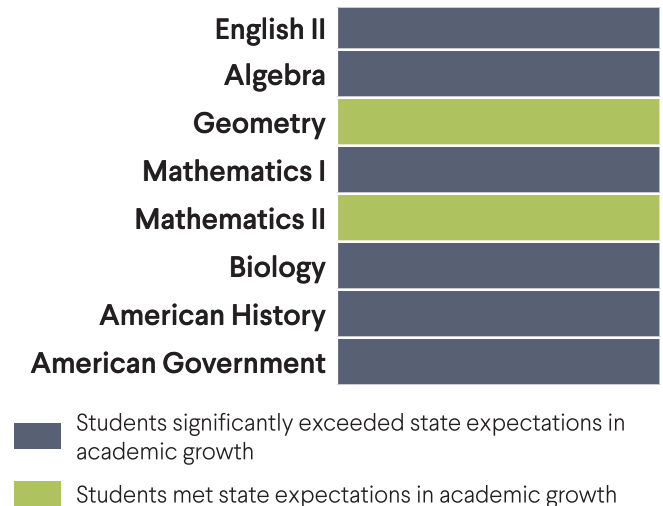

St. Aloysius, as the sponsor of this school, is legally mandated to provide oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance.
