

Cornerstone Academy is an award-winning public charter school serving K-12 students at two Westerville locations: Grades K-7 at the main campus, and Grades 8-12 at the new high school campus.

Celebrating 20 years of service to the community, Cornerstone Academy scores in the Top 5% of Ohio community schools and teaches a rigorous college prep curriculum offering Art, Health, Music, PE, Technology, and Writing as well as a broad range of extracurricular activities including Marching Band, Robotics, Sculpture and more.

Students can participate in competitive sports including Basketball, Girls Volleyball, Coed Soccer and Cheerleading. The school's thriving College Credit Plus program experienced 200% growth this year. The 18 seniors in the Class of 2023 earned \$3.4M in college scholarships and were accepted to 25 colleges and universities.






STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS


DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE


ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Cornerstone Academy's goals for the 2022-23 school year were to:

- Raise ELA proficiency rate by 5% and PI by 5 points
- Raise Math proficiency rate by 10% and PI by 10 points
- Maintain an attendance rate of 94% and disciplinary actions to 8% or less of the student population

Cornerstone Academy earned 4.5 stars Overall and met or exceeded all state expectations in student academic achievement and growth. Additionally, the school met or made progress on their goals including strong gains in ELA & Math. The school's student attendance rate increased, but student disciplinary action exceeded the 8% target.





St. Aloysius, as the sponsor of this school, is legally mandated to provide oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance. As part of the monitoring process, the performance of the school is assessed and evaluated on each of the required Ohio School Report Card components. Additionally, St. Aloysius has a regular presence at school board meetings where student performance indicators such as attendance, behavior, and academic achievement are tracked and financial and organizational issues that impact student success are reviewed and discussed. Key to the oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance is St. Aloysius' review of the school's Ohio Improvement Process (OIP) plan development and implementation. As a result of our thorough oversight and monitoring, St. Aloysius has determined that this school is substantially compliant with the rules and regulations governing community schools.

All community school sponsors are required to submit a written report of the evaluation results of the school's academic, financial, and organizational performance, as well as the school's legal compliance with Ohio Revised Code, Ohio Administrative Code, and to the terms of the Community School contract. This report must be made available to parents of students enrolled in the community school by November 30th of each year under OAC 3301-102-05 (A) (3).
